1:30 p.m. Inside Check-in by 1 p.m. Cattle, Goats, Hogs, Horses, and Sheep that are ready to go back to your farm or head to a processor

Sunday Drop-Off

With a Monday Sale Day, some consignors need to drop off their items on Sunday. Livestock can be dropped off using the cards on the dock. Hay and straw need to be labeled with consignor's name, address, and phone number. We advise placing your paper in a baggy and making sure it is secure from the wind. There is no early drop-off for small animals or Endless Treasures. All items left are at the consignor's risk.

Pullorum Testing



Pullorum is an infectious poultry disease that the Ohio Department of Agriculture requires testing for in birds older than 16 weeks of age. Turkeys must have a different test (cannot be tested at the sale barn). Doves, pigeons, and waterfowl are exempt. For more information, visit ohiopoultry.org

Our Monday sale day starts with our 9 a.m. Endless Treasures Sale (formerly called Inside Misc) in the sale ring. We sell everything from tools, household items, décor, and toys to produce, food/pantry items and baked goods. We have worked hard to increase the quality of this sale. We break at 11:30 a.m. to sell eggs and then split into two rings: small animals (poultry, rabbits, etc.) sell outside while we finish up

with any inside treasures we still have for the day.

Immediately following, we begin the outside Endless Treasures Sale (formerly called Outside Misc) where you can find a wide range of larger items like farm supplies, equipment, trailers, lumber, and more!
